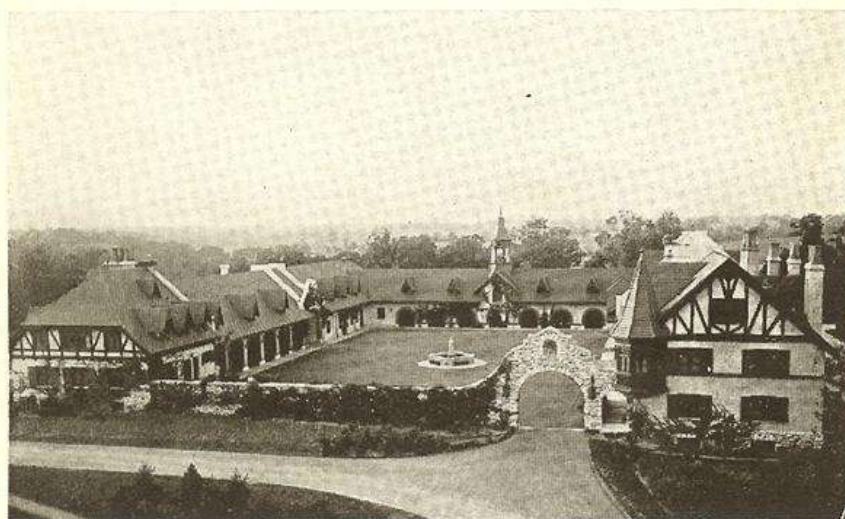

In looking for a suitable sire to place at the head of our herd we exerted considerable care and thoughtful attention, finally finding what we wanted in the herd of Col. E. H. Taylor, Jr., Frankfort, Ky. We selected WOODFORD 35TH, a most worthy son of the old sire WOODFORD 500000. This choice bull has proved to be a great breeder, and, as he is included in this sale offering, will undoubtedly be a real attraction. Some good youngsters, five of them, are also listed, and the breeder who is wanting some good young sires, at a price he can well afford to pay, will do well to come and look these over.

Terms and Conditions

Each animal will be sold separately to the highest bidder, without reserve.

The auctioneers will settle any dispute as to bids by declaring all bids off and reselling the animal in question.

Each animal will be at the purchaser's risk as soon as sold, but will not be delivered until settlement has been made.

After sold, the animals will be fed and cared for until they are loaded on the cars. This service will be free, but at the purchaser's risk of loss or injury.

Terms of the sale are cash, unless other arrangements are made before the sale.

Six months time may be had with seven per cent interest. Anyone desiring time must bring acceptable banking reference.

All animals of breeding age are guaranteed breeders. Females in calf or with calf at foot are considered breeders, without further guaranty. All untried animals are guaranteed to be without known defects, but nothing further. Animals failing to breed after a trial of six months may be returned, if in good condition. The seller reserves the right for six months to try the animal, and if it proves a breeder to return it to the buyer at his expense. If the animal proves a non-breeder, purchase price will be refunded.

Persons who find it impossible to be present on day of sale can send bids to any of the auctioneers or to the seller, and you will be assured of a square deal.

The Little Black-Irish Cows

MR. BUSCH also will sell at the auction his entire herd of Registered Irish Dexter Cattle, comprised of 13 cows and calves and one bull. Irish Dexter herds are so rare in America as to be unique. The Busch herd is considered one of the finest in this country, and has been developed from foundation stock from the Elmendorf Farm at Lexington, Ky. The original herd was imported by the Elmendorf Farms in 1909.

There are only seven breeders of Kerry and Dexter cattle in the United States recognized by the American Kerry and Dexter Cattle Club. Besides Mr. Busch and the Elmendorf Farm, the other breeders are Daniel Guggenheim, New York; the James J. Hill Estate" Gladstone, Minn.; James N. Hill, New York; E. F. Sims, Houston, Tex., and F. E. Stevens, Glen Falls, N. Y.

The Irish Dexter cows are famous throughout Ireland and England, particularly on account of their unusual milk production at a very low cost. The Dexter cows weigh less than 700 pounds, but produce from 28 to 32 pounds of milk a day. In general appearance, these cows have stylish carriage, are solid deep black in color, and have short heads, with horns of moderate length, springing well from the head with inward and upward curve.

Mr. Busch's Irish Dexter bull is a perfect type of this breeding. He is a very fine individual bull, a sure breeder, and is a high class show prospect. His calves are all true to the Irish Dexter Type.

The Irish Dexter cattle will be sold subject to tuberculin test. Since Mr. Busch has owned the herd, which he bought in 1914, he has never had a Dexter animal to react tuberculosis.

The Busch herd offers an exceptional opportunity to any breeder wishing to establish himself in the breeding of Irish Dexter cattle of the purest blood in this country. In England and Ireland nearly everybody from the humblest peasant to the King owns Irish Dexter cattle. His Majesty, King George, was the winner of the Challenge Cup in the Royal Agricultural Society of England Show, Manchester, 1916. Dinah

(2017), the winning cow, produced 44 pounds of milk in one day.

The Irish Dexter cow is the real economy cow. A cow of this type can be profitably kept on the small lot of the average suburban home. The breeder who will popularize this breed of cattle will render a distinct public service, particularly to the small home owner. There is a wide field for the promotion of Irish Dexter Cattle in America.
