

How to Register a Bull Calf

Bull calves must be genotyped and <u>sire qualified</u> prior to registration. The ADCA website has forms and instructions for this process.

Registrations can be done either online or by mail. Before beginning the registration, you may want to have the following items available to refer to:

- 1) Breeder's ADCA number,
- 2) Owner's or buyer's ADCA number or contact information if not a current member
- 3) Information about the calf: birth date, tattoo/USDA 840 tag, color, polled/horned
- 4) If you had testing done, know where these items are on your computer for uploading with the registration or make copies to mail if sending registration application by mail
- 5) Dam's ADCA number and dam's owner at time of calving
- 6) Sire's ADCA number and sire's owner. THE SIRE'S GENOTYPE MUST BE ON FILE WITH THE ADCA IN ORDER TO PROCEED.
- A. Visit the ADCA website and select the <u>REGISTRATIONS</u> tab at the top of the home page. This will bring you to a page that has important information to read before registering your animal.
- B. From the <u>Registration Information</u> page you may choose to print off a form and mail it in to the ADCA, or you can proceed to the <u>Online Registration</u> form.
- C. If you are completing your registration online, you will come to a STOP page that has more important information for you to read before going further to the online registration form.

STEP 1	Fill in all fields with the information you gathered from the list above
STEP 2	If available, upload lab results when prompted, or be sure to make copies for the mail
STEP 3	Hit the SUBMIT button
